Student's Imprest Account

The following expenses are recovered from the Student's Imprest Account which should always be maintained at **Rs 10,000** per student as per the School Policy.

Particulars of charges:

- 1) Uniforms (including winter uniform & sports dress)
- 2) Text books & Note books
- 3) Stationery and other items
- 4) Educational tours/ Long tour excursions
- 5) Personal requirements
- 6) ICSE/ISC Board Registration Charges
- 7) Outside medical consultancy
- 8) Other charges out of Imprest

Please Note:-

- At the time of admission, the student must provide 6 Passport-sized Photos, one set of parents, along with the recent Report Card, Aadhaar Cards for both student and the parents, the birth certificate and Original Transfer Certificate. Failure to submit these documents will result in incomplete admission.
- Registration does not ensure admission. The child is required to take an admission test. If the test is passed, an interview with the child and parents will be arranged on the same day. The management reserves the right to accept or deny a student's admission.
- After a child is selected, parents will be notified. To confirm the admission, fees need to be paid deposited within the specified timeframe. Failure to do so, the seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate.
- During check-in time, parents must provide their child's complete medical history. Please be aware that admission cannot be finalized without this documentation.
- If the student has not attended a single day in the school after admission, withdrawn by the parent for any personal reason or by the school for misconduct anytime during the school year, there is no refund of any fees. Only Imprest deposit will be refunded.
- The Imprest Deposit covers the cost of all chargeable incidentals such as damage to the School property, replacement of lost books & fine etc.
- **If a student chooses to transfer to another school, they should fill the student leaving form by December 31st and all dues need to be cleared. Failing to do so will result in losing all funds.**
- A discount of Rs. 5000 shall be given to those who pay the total year fees as a single payment in the beginning of the academic year.
- 20% discount on tuition fees is available for younger brothers, and devotee parents can also receive a 20% discount if they provide a letter from the local temple President.
- Late fee penalty of Rs.50/- per day (including holidays) after the due date.
- Student should Check-In on the given date otherwise penalty of Rs.500 per day will apply.
- Cheque bouncing is a criminal offence. Kindly honor your cheque otherwise a fine of Rs. 5000/- will be imposed.
- Students will not be permitted to appear in the final exam and no transfer certificate will be issued if the fees are not paid in full.
- Meeting of parents and students is not permitted during school working hours.
- BGIS take pride in maintaining a high standard of discipline, a strong code of conduct and a zero tolerance policy. All students are expected to adhere punctuality in attendance, appropriate behavior and language, show respect for teachers, and comply with school rules and regulations.
- Students must always attend school in uniform, and with neatly trimmed hair. Long hair is not permitted.
- Senior students are not allowed to ride two-wheelers to school.
- All students should board in the first bus at 7:00 AM. If the student board in the second bus fine will be imposed or my refuse to board the bus by the driver.
- Day scholar students should not stay in the campus after hours, unless if some event is taking place with Principal Permission.
