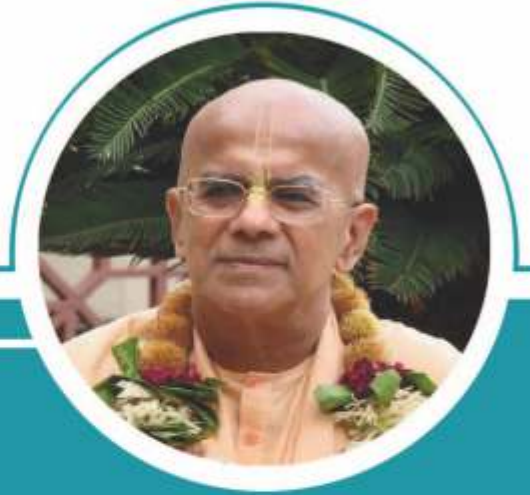

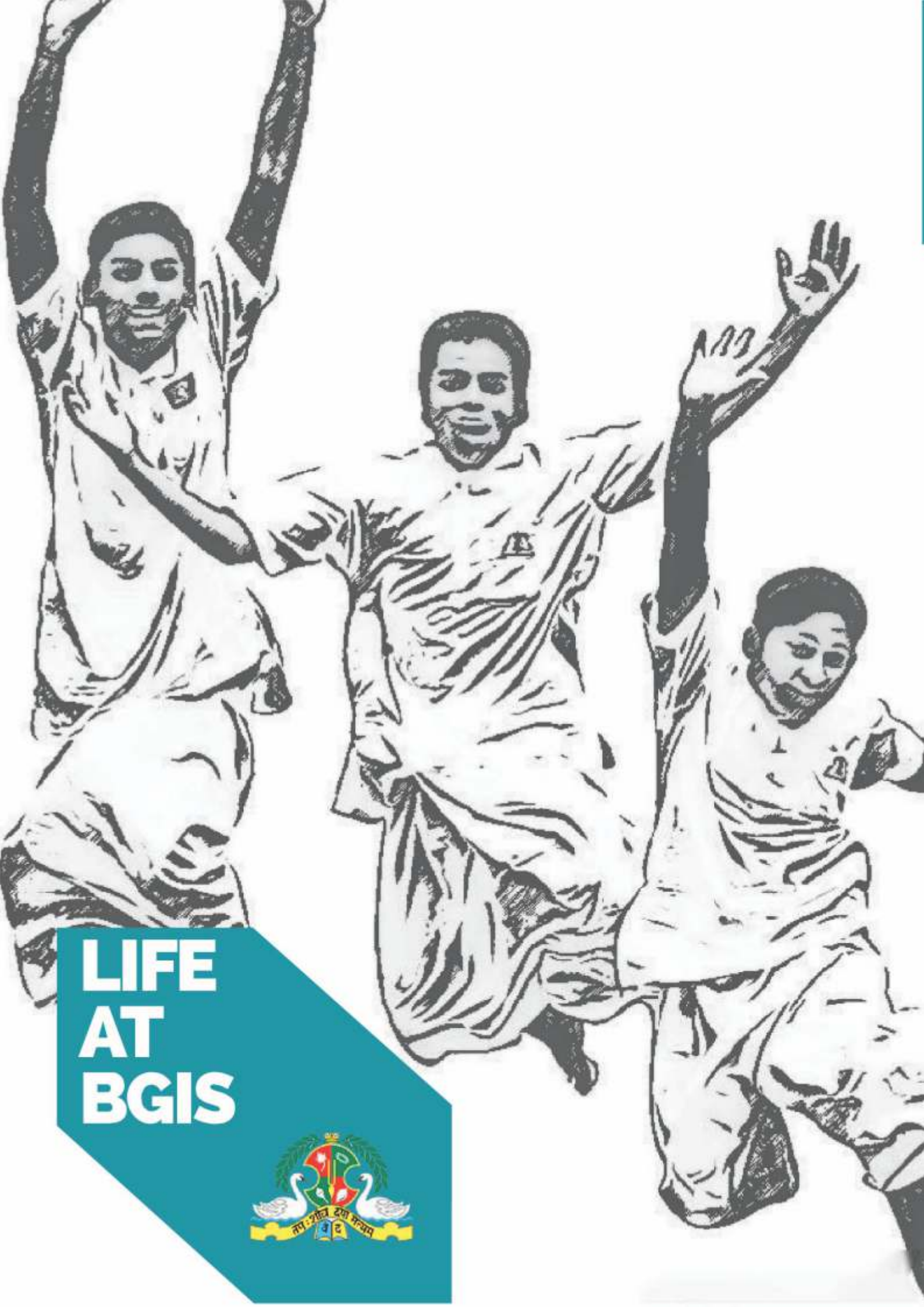

BGIS IS ORGANIZED INTO TWO LEVELS

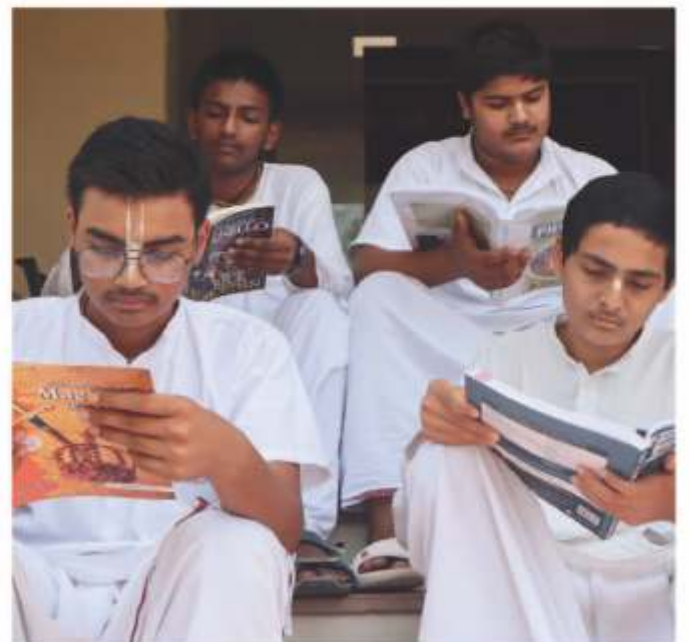
1. Gurukula the primary level, classes 1-8

GURUKULA: THE PRIMARY LEVEL

It consists of classes from 1-8. The primary level focuses not only on core academic subjects like languages, Math, Science and Social Studies but children are also trained in core value education based on the Bhagavad Gita and Bhagavatam. In addition they learn Music, Art and Computers as well.

INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL: THE SECONDARY

The high school students, classes 9-12, take their final exams with the CISCE Board of Education, an internationally recognized board located in New Delhi, India. High school students can choose from a wide range of subjects and can specialize in Science, Business or Commerce. We strive to meet the academic goals of each student by offering extra classes or coaching as needed. The council offers a wide range of subject choices to include in the core academic, as well as art, music, physical education, and computer applications.



SVARUCHI CLUB

Gurukula understands the needs of each and every child who have their own special capabilities and interest. So if that child is given a chance in their field of interest, they would even blossom more in their academics also. BGIS has started this SVARUCHI CLUB with the motive to give a special time for children to learn their keen areas apart from academics, under special experts so that they can attain heights and excel at the national level in that field and also improve their overall personality.

SPORTS



Sports serve as a healthy outlet for the boy's youthful energy. Besides providing excellent physical exercise, it helps develop quick thinking, the ability to work in teams, and the capacity to acknowledge the skills and capabilities of others. Students are trained in games like volleyball, basket ball, badminton, table tennis, kabaddi and kho-kho. The school holds an annual Sports Day and also participates in various inter school sports competitions.



MUSIC AND DANCE



The Music Department of our school gives training to students in Indian traditional instruments such as the Mridanga and Harmonium. We also train them in vocal Hindustani classical music as well as bhajans. Students also have the opportunity to learn 'Gotipua', a traditional Odissi dance for boys that is a traditional dance form of Odisha. Traditional Indian music is a powerful and devotional art form and we encourage all students to actively engage in any one of them.

ASHRAM LIFE

A fundamental and unique aspect of the BGIS experience is regular spiritual practices like rising early, mantra meditation, bhajans, kirtans and shastric studies. Both teachers and students strictly follow four basic tenets of spiritual values austerly, compassion, cleanliness and truthfulness. Students learn these values by following the devotional practices, through exposure to cow protection and organic farm communities.

Here, the students imbibe in their hearts a devotion to Lord Krishna based on the teachings of the Bhagvad-Gita. Teachings are delivered not sentimentally or dogmatically but in a philosophical and cultural way, using both contemporary and traditional educational methods. This is why we call ourselves a Gurukula.

Students are privileged to attend many retreats in places such as Mayapur, Jagannatha Puri, Udupi, Gangotri, Jamunautri, and Simla during their stay in BGIS.

VAISHNAVA CULTURE

Ancient vaisnava culture, is a tradition of mutual respect ,integrity, compassion, cleanliness (internal and external), mercy and tolerance. Students are taught to manage their emotions and channelize their energies positively and constructively.

MANGALA ARATI

Mangal Artik according to vaisnava tradition is a very important part of the day. Students get up at 5 a.m. to worship Lord Krishna in the temple. They do this everyday inspite of the weather, except Sunday.



JAPA MEDITATION

The Importance of Reciting the Lord's Holy Name

Recitation of the Lord's Holy Name is regarded as the most crucial yoga practice across various traditions. This practice helps to establish a robust spiritual foundation and enables individuals to face the challenges of life. It is recommended that students chant the Hare Krsna Mahamantra at least four rounds daily.



DEITY WORSHIP

At each ashram, Lord Krishna is venerated in His Deity form. Following japa chanting, students participate in rituals such as waking up the Deity, bathing, dressing, performing puja, and arati. This daily observance facilitates a more profound comprehension of Vaisnava culture, where the belief in Lord Krishna's Personal form is instilled.



HONORING PRASAD

The Vaishnava tradition places significant importance on offering food to Lord Krishna. Following this practice BGIS provides students with a wholesome diet, comprising of milk, grains, fruits, and vegetables, that are first offered to the lord. This approach enables individuals to consume food that is beneficial for both the body and soul, ultimately aiding in their spiritual growth as devotees.



OUR CARE

HEALTHY FOOD:

BGIS students relish in the consumption of organic cuisine grown on-campus. Moreover, they have access to fresh, pure cow's milk sourced from the in-house Goshala.

HEALTHY SLEEPING HABITS::

Our primary grade students sleep as early as 7:30 pm and high school students by 9:30pm. They also rise as early as 4 am.

24/7 HEALTH CARE FACILITES:

BGIS provides round-the-clock medical facilities for our students with a well-equipped Health Center and a 24-hour nurse available. In addition to this, we also have doctors on campus during the day. We are pleased to announce that we have now added a full-time Ayurveda doctor on campus to further enhance our healthcare

CHILD PROTECTION TEAM:

At BGIS, we have a strict no-tolerance policy towards all forms of child abuse, including corporal punishment. Our Child Protection team conducts regular health and safety training for both students and staff.

SECURITY

We provide 24-hour security coverage, with 20 security guards and a security manager available to ensure the safety of our campus.

The entire area is under CCTV surveillance.

POLICE STATION

Furthermore, our police station is located at the entrance of the main gate, providing round-the-clock support and protection for our students and staff. Rest assured, the safety and well-being of our community is our top priority.





OUR ADMISSION PROCESS

Admissions

The school's academic session commences in April annually. Admissions for standards 1st to 9th and standard 11th begin in January and are granted based on merit. A comprehensive admission test evaluates the candidate's proficiency level in English, Mathematics, and Science, based on their current grade level. Boys who qualify the written test are invited for an interview to assess their habits, social interactions, and aptitude.

Fee structure

The school operates as a non-profit organization, and the fees charged solely serve to cover the institution's operational costs. Our teacher-student ratio is optimized to ensure personalized attention, and our facilities include international-standard amenities such as a swimming pool, a large playground, and more. The fee encompasses all expenses related to the student, such as uniforms, books, stationery, yoga retreats, and more. In comparison to other international residential schools in India, our fee structure is highly competitive and reasonable.

LESSONS | FOR LIFE



Preparing for competitive exams

Students here prepare for competitive exams like IIT, JEE, NEET, CA Foundation and CLAT Exams to achieve their goals. Gurukula Students also appear in Olympiad Tests in different subjects like Science, Maths & English.

The IIT Foundation class is a preparatory course designed for students of Class 9 & 10 to help students establish a strong foundation for these exams. By focusing on fundamental concepts of Science and Mathematics, this course provides students with necessary skills and strategies to tackle complex problems.



Bhakti Sastri Course

This course offers a comprehensive exploration of Bhagavad-Gita, Sri Isopanisad, Nectar of Devotion, and Nectar of Instruction. Intended for devotees with at least a year of sincere and serious practice in Krishna consciousness, as well as a basic understanding of sastra, the Bhakti Sastri curriculum provides a systematic study of Srila Prabhupada's works. Through interactive discussions and group activities based on the books, participants can enhance their sastric knowledge and develop the skills to convey Gaudiya Vaishnav principles to the wider society.

Notably, students from grades 8 to 12 are also eligible to enroll and benefit from the course. The first Bhakti Sastri batch had 20 BGIS students who successfully completed the program, and a Bhakti Sastri degree will be awarded to qualified students from the ISKCON Board of Examination upon completion. The course content includes a deep dive into Bhagavad-gita, Śrī Īsopanisad, Nectar of Devotion, and Nectar of Instruction.



Cow Care Center

The Surabhi Gau Gram is a centralized facility located within the 60-acre ISKCON BGIS campus in Braj Vrindavan Dham. It serves as a shelter for cows, but it's more than that. It's an analytics-enabled cow care and cow product training facility. Supported by NDRI and NSDC, the facility collates all cow-related data, ranging from health incidents to feeding frequency and fodder, to provide real-time insights on cow care. We also impart cow care knowledge to hundreds of farmers annually, including the utilization of dung and urine as alternative sources of income.

Moreover, the Gurukula students engage in various services for mother cows every week, such as cleaning sheds, feeding, and milking them. The students derive immense joy from serving their eternal mothers and performing these duties.
